### **October's Demonstration will be given by our own Bruce Kotchy.**

Bruce is a native of Pittsburgh and earned a Bachelor of Science in Journalism from Ohio University and a Masters in Public Relations from Ball State University. He spent seven years in the Air Force at Cape Canaveral, Taiwan and Ogden, Utah. He has worked for GTE for 20 years in Iowa, Indiana and Florida and has also worked for the Pinellas County Arts Council. Bruce began with colored pencil drawing around '97 at the Dunedin Art Center and after experimenting with several media there discovered acrylic paint. After this discovery he was hooked! Bruce paints fast and his subject matter is varied. Leading the Treasure Island Art Guild Thursday morning workshop for the past several years has given him a great deal of pleasure, not only the painting itself but the interactions with "his students." ### **Expressive Portrait Painting Class (Oils / Acrylics) @, [www.gigurtsis.com](http://www.gigurtsis.com)**

**Skill Level:** Intermediate to advanced levels of oil or acrylic painting

This course teaches the tools and techniques to enable you to paint expressive portraits. Students will learn how to: get basic proportions of the head, use comparative method to capture an accurate likeness of the sitter, use a limited palette of colors, handle paint and edge control, use color and value to create a convincing impression of light; and technical information regarding materials. By the end of the course, you will complete two portraits, working with the same life model over three sessions you will learn how to observe, measure and use paint in order to bring the composition to life. Each class limited to 8 students to allow the tutor to individually guide and support each student.
